

**NORMAN TOWNSHIP
ANNUAL MEETING OF THE ELECTORS DRAFT MINUTES
JUNE 24, 2023**

Supervisor Mobley called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m. Present: Supervisor Mobley, Treasurer Tighe, Clerk Montgomery, Trustee Fraley an (5) electors of Norman Township.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS YEARS MINUTES: Montgomery moved, Tighe seconded to approve the previous year's minutes indicating there was no annual meeting due to lack of quorum. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF SALARY RESOLUTIONS:

1. Montgomery moved, Tighe seconded to approve the Salary Resolutions of the Supervisor, Clerk and Treasurer for FY 2023-2024. Motion Carried unanimously. No increases in salary were proposed from the previous year.

STATE OF THE TOWNSHIP: Supervisor Mobley indicated everything is going pretty well. Improvements to Crystal Lake, New docks are going in, and that the Board has done an effective and efficient job utilizing the Covid Funds to enhance and improve Township facilities. Further that he is looking into cemetery upgrades with consideration of some markings to figure out location of things.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Elector requested information on how ambulance services work and requested a transcript of meeting held, years back, when information on the subject was presented. Supervisor Mobley explained that the meetings held were Town Hall meetings and no transcripts exist. He advised that ambulance services are billed to insurance carriers however Norman Township tax payers do not pay any additional costs for services beyond what is reimbursed by their insurance carrier when Norman Township ambulance services are utilized. In the event Norman Township is not able to respond, services provided by any other service are billed in full. Elector also requested consideration of a farmers' market in the community and indicated they would have a representative from the Michigan Department of Rural Development address the Board on the subject at a later date.

ADJOURNMENT: Fraley moved; Tighe seconded to adjourn at 11:21 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
