In accordance with Michigan Election Law, Act 116 of 1954 Section 168.653 (a), notice is hereby given to the registered voters of Norman Township that the Primary Election will be held TUESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2024

Early Voting is available at Maple Grove Township 9208 Kauko St, Kaleva, Michigan 49645 from July 27, 2024 through August 4, 2024 from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

On Election Day Norman Township polling location is open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. EST. Polling place location for Norman Township is:

MANISTEE COUNTY PROPOSALS:

RENEWAL OF MANISTEE COUNTY SEPARATE TAX LIMITATIONS PROPOSITION

Shall separate tax limitations be established for a period of two years (2024 through 2026 inclusive) or until altered by the voters of Manistee County for the County of Manistee and Townships and Intermediate School Districts within the County the aggregate of which shall not exceed 7.3 mils as follows: County of Manistee 5.5 mils, Townships 1.5 miles, Intermediate School Districts .3 mils. **YES OR NO.**

MANISTEE COUNTY LIBRARY MILAGE RENEWAL

Shall the County of Manistee, State of Michigan renew a previously voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within the County of Manistee, State of Michigan at 1.000 mils (\$1.00 per 1000 of taxable value) for the period of three years 2024-2026 inclusive, for operational and building maintenance cost at the Manistee County Library, and shall the County of Manistee levy such a renewal in milage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$1,507,177.97? **YES OR NO.**

NORMAN TOWNSHIP PROPOSALS:

AMBULANCE OPERATIONS

Shall Norman Township, Manistee County, Michigan, increase the constitutional limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed upon real and tangible personal property for all purposes in Norman Township, Manistee County, Michigan, by an additional one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1000 taxable valuation) and levy an additional one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1000 of taxable valuation) for a period of two (2) years (2024-2025, inclusive) for Township ambulance operations and maintenance? (This is a renewal request of the one (1) mill for ambulance operations and maintenance for two (2) years which expired in 2023. If approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year would be approximately \$83,470.) **YES OR NO**

FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS

Shall Norman Township, Manistee County, Michigan, increase the constitutional limitation on the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed upon real and tangible personal property for all purposes in Norman Township, Manistee County, Michigan, by an additional two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1000 of taxable valuation) and levy an additional two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1000 of taxable valuation) for a period of two (2) years (2024-2025, inclusive) for Township Fire Department operations and maintenance? (This is a renewal of the two (2) mills for Township Fire Department operations and maintenance for two (2) years which expired in 2023. If approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year would be approximately \$166,940.) **YES OR NO.**
